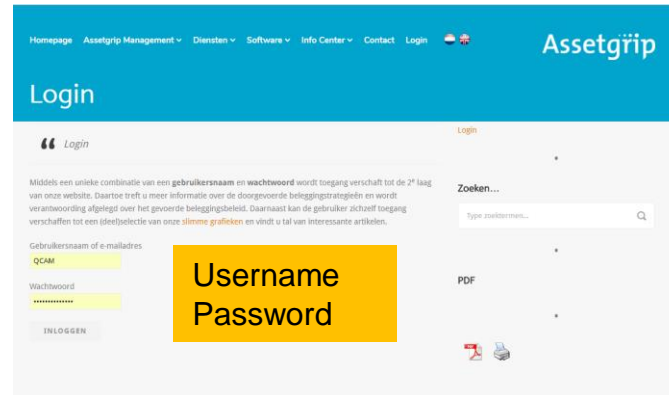
- Install Google Authentication on your Smart Phone

1. Installing Google Authentication on Smartphone

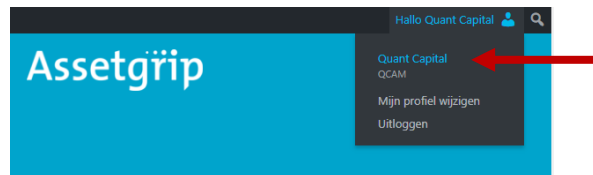
- Apple

- Windows

 - Search for: "Google Authenticator"
 - Download/Install App

2. Activate Google Autenticator on Website...

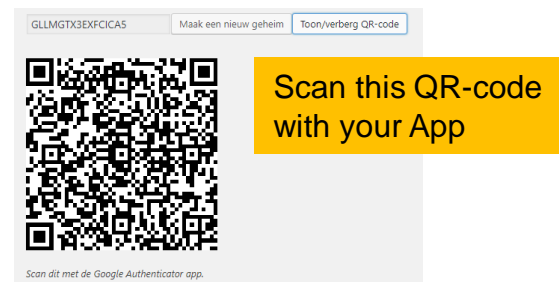
➤ Login with Username + Password




➤ Select first Menu-item
